The networking option adds to the already impressive benefits of the Apollo T80 including the unit's ease of installation, the fail-safe battery-charging defaults, and the exclusive built-in energy monitor.

The Apollo Network Option hardware also provides communications to monitor and record system performance through the Apollo remote data display that is offered in both wired and wireless models.
